Dear Parents:

Bus Service for Corpus Christi School is provided between the St. Philip's and St. Anthony's campuses by Williams Bus Lines. The fees for bus service are set based upon our cost. At this time, a 5% or more increase is anticipated by the bus company. The fees for the 2010-2011 school year are as follows:

Registration Fee (Non-refundable)	\$30.00 per Family
One Way Inter Campus Shuttle	\$50.00 per Month
AM and PM Inter Campus Shuttle	\$95.00 per Month

Registration

As many of you know, the bus shuttle is in high demand. To register for consideration for bus service for the 2010-2011 school year, please complete the bus registration form on the reverse side. **A separate form is needed for each child.** Return the form as soon as possible and no later than May 3, 2010. Children will be considered for placement for bus service on a first come first serve basis so it is important that you return your forms and registration fee as soon as possible. **Even if your child is riding the bus for the current school year, you still must complete and submit a bus registration form.**

Payment Procedures

The registration fee is due with the registration form as soon as possible but no later than May 3, 2010.

Monthly charges for bus riders will be made through FACTS over 9 months (September through May) unless the full year's fees are paid by June 1, 2010.

Route Assignments and Fee Notification

You will receive written notification, by mail, of the shuttle bus times and monthly payment amount.

School Bus Registration Form and Rules for School Year 2010-2011

MANDATORY BUS RULES

Listed below you will find some of the bus rules and regulations that apply to all students riding the bus. After three warnings for any rule violations, with the exception of rule #10, a student will be removed from the bus for a period of time for the safety of everyone. Parents are asked to understand and cooperate with the driver and school officials when discipline matters are involved.

1. The bus drivers(s) are in charge of the bus, please obey and respect them at all times. They have the authority to assign seats.
2. Be at your bus stop at least 10 minutes early. Drivers cannot control traffic and may arrive a few minutes early or after the scheduled time. Please be patient.
3. **No smoking**, drinking, eating or gum chewing allowed at any time on the bus.
4. Students are to enter the bus quickly and orderly, choose a seat, and remain seated facing forward at all times. Do not change seats or stand at any time unless directed to do so by the driver.
5. Talk quietly so as not to distract the bus driver. **Do not yell or scream at any time.** Remember that the driver must be able to hear emergency vehicles approaching. The bus is an extension of the classroom therefore no disruptive behavior is expected or tolerated. The bus drivers deserve and expect the same respect as your teacher.
6. At no time shall any body part be extended out the window of the bus. Do not throw anything out of or into the bus window. All emergency exits and aisles must be kept clear at all times.
7. No animals, dead or alive, of any type, are permitted on the bus at any time.
8. Students are not to sit in, or be around, the driver area of the bus at any time.
9. Students will only be permitted to get on or off the bus at their designated bus stop. If going home with a friend or at another stop, they must have permission from the school in writing. Some schools do not allow extra riders; please check with your school about their policy.
10. **Use of profane language or aggressive behavior, possession of weapons for any reason, or vandalism of the bus in any manner, will result in immediate loss of bus ridership privileges.** Any costs associated with cleaning and/or repairing the bus as a result of aggressive behavior or vandalism will be charged back to the school for collection to those involved.
