

Required Kindergarten Immunizations for the 2008-09 School Year Updated April 1, 2008

The state of Virginia requires all students entering Kindergarten must have 2 MMR (mumps, measles, rubella). Also a vision and hearing test is required. Students without complete records must be excluded from school until requirements are completed. Please submit this information as soon as possible to the Clinic.

UPDATE FROM VA. DEPT. OF HEALTH-MARCH 2008:

“This is to inform you that the second dose of mumps and varicella vaccine will not be required for attendance in the upcoming 2008/09 school year. This is a change from information we provided earlier. These doses are on the Recommended Immunization Schedule and should be administered to children you serve in your clinics, however, they cannot be required for school attendance until the revised regulations are approved by the Board of Health and the regulatory process is completed. This will not occur in time for enrollment in the 2008/09 school year. We are also in the process of amending the Minimum Standards for School Entry document on our Web site to reflect this correction.”
