

# Corpus Christi Elementary Campus Uniform Requirement

The students in grades one through eight wear a standard uniform. This uniform may be purchased through Flynn and O'Hara located at Fair City Mall in Fairfax, Virginia. Their website is [www.flynnohara.com](http://www.flynnohara.com). Most parts of the uniform can be purchased at other children's clothing stores except the items that are noted.

## Standard Uniform pieces required from 1 October – 30 April

- Uniform can also be worn the first and last month of school in lieu of the warm weather uniform

### ❖ Boys

- Dark Navy Blue Pants
  - Dark navy twill or small wale corduroy pants with a black belt
- Shirts
  - White or yellow dress shirt or button down oxford (Long or short sleeves)
- Dark Navy Blue Sweater (Optional)
  - Dark navy blue; choice of V-neck pullover, V-neck vest, V-neck cardigan, or crew neck cardigan
    - Most boys wear their PE sweatshirt in lieu of vests and sweaters
- Socks
  - Dark navy or white
- Shoes
  - Leather dress shoes (no sneaker or tennis shoes except on designated PE day)
- Uniform Tie (**MUST BE PURCHASED AT THE UNIFORM STORE**)
  - Boys in grades 4 – 8 must wear a tie from 1 October – 30 April

### ❖ Girls Standard Uniform

- Jumpers (Grades 1 – 5; **(MUST BE PURCHASED AT THE UNIFORM STORE)**)
  - Dark navy plaid jumper
- Kiln skirt and dark navy blue vest (Grades 6 – 8; **MUST BE PURCHASED AT THE UNIFORM STORE**)
  - Dark navy plaid skirt and solid dark blue vest
  - If a girl wears PE sweatshirt, she does NOT have to wear vest

### For all girls in grades 1 – 8

- Blouses
  - White or yellow, peter pan collar (Long or short sleeve)
  - Girls may also wear white or yellow turtlenecks
- Sweaters
  - Optional. Dark navy blue; choice of V-neck pullover, V-neck vest, V-neck cardigan, or crew neck cardigan
    - Most girls wear their PE sweatshirt in lieu of vests and sweaters
- Socks
  - Dark navy knee socks
  - White ankle socks may be worn August through 30 September and 1 May through June
  - Cable or opaque tights may be worn from October through April
- Shoes
  - Leather dress shoes (no sneaker or tennis shoes)

## **Warm Weather Uniform**

Warm weather uniform can be worn from the beginning of school through 1 October and from 1 May through the end of the school year. The shirts are unisex. Only the shirt must be purchased through the uniform store.

- ❖ White or yellow knit/polo shirt with 'Corpus Christi' embroidered
  - **Must be purchased through uniform store**
- ❖ Navy walking shorts with a leather belt (girls shorts are cuffed)
  - Can be purchased at other children's clothing store
- ❖ Leather dress shoes (same as for standard school uniform)
- ❖ Crew socks – not ankle socks

## **PE Uniform**

- ❖ Same for boys and girls
  - There is a warm weather and cold weather uniform
- ❖ Will be measured at the beginning of the school year
  - Students get warm weather uniform right after labor day
  - Sweats usually arrive in October
- ❖ Can only be ordered through the school **NOT** the uniform store
- ❖ Tennis shoes are to be worn with PE uniform on student's designated PE day

**It is suggested that a student have at least two sets of everything in case something is lost. LABEL ALL CLOTHES WITH YOUR CHILD'S NAME.**

**The school's PTO has two used uniform sales: one at the beginning of school, usually right after Labor Day AND a second one at the end of the school year, usually the first week in June. Ask the Main Office for more information.**
